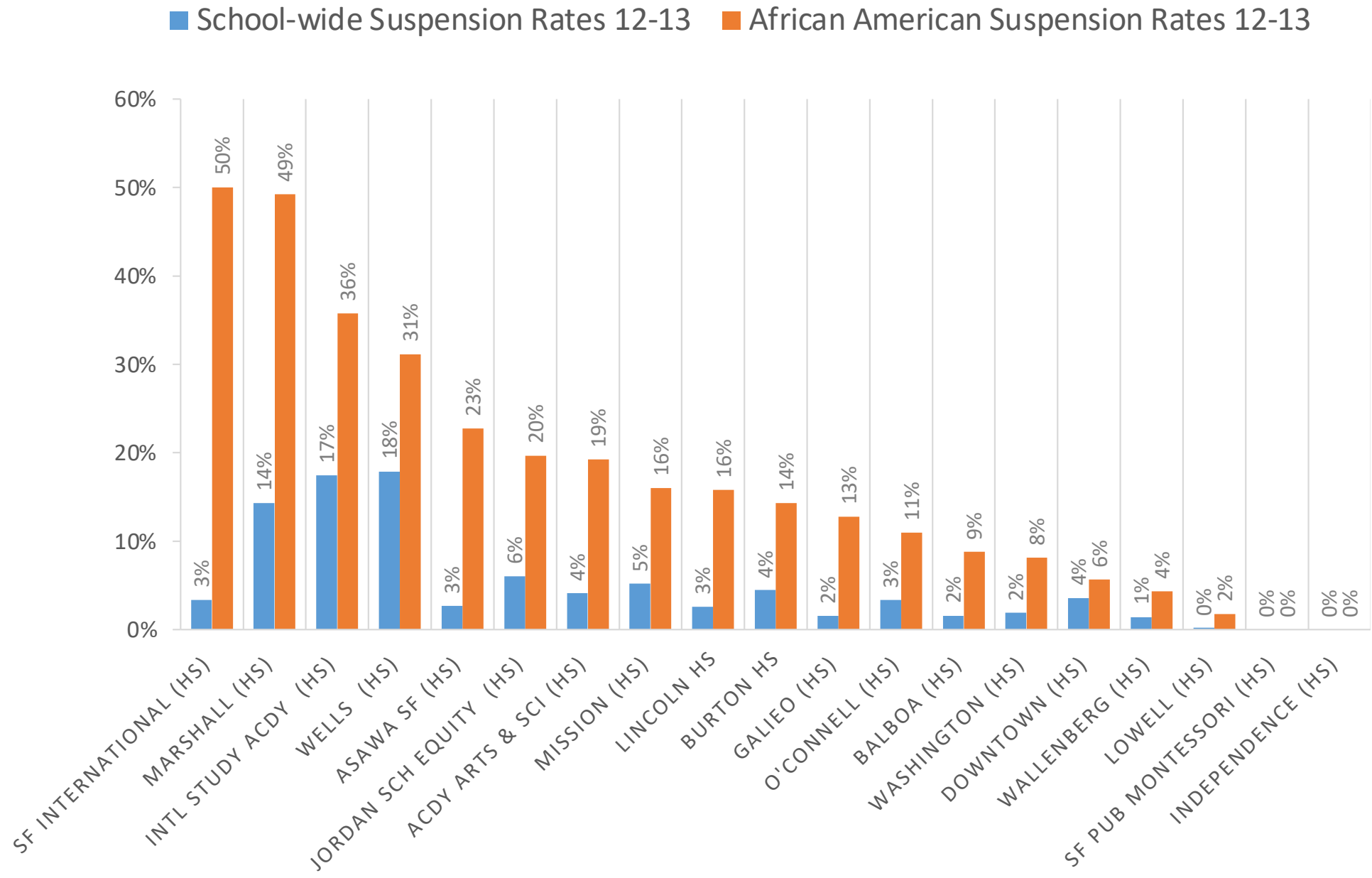


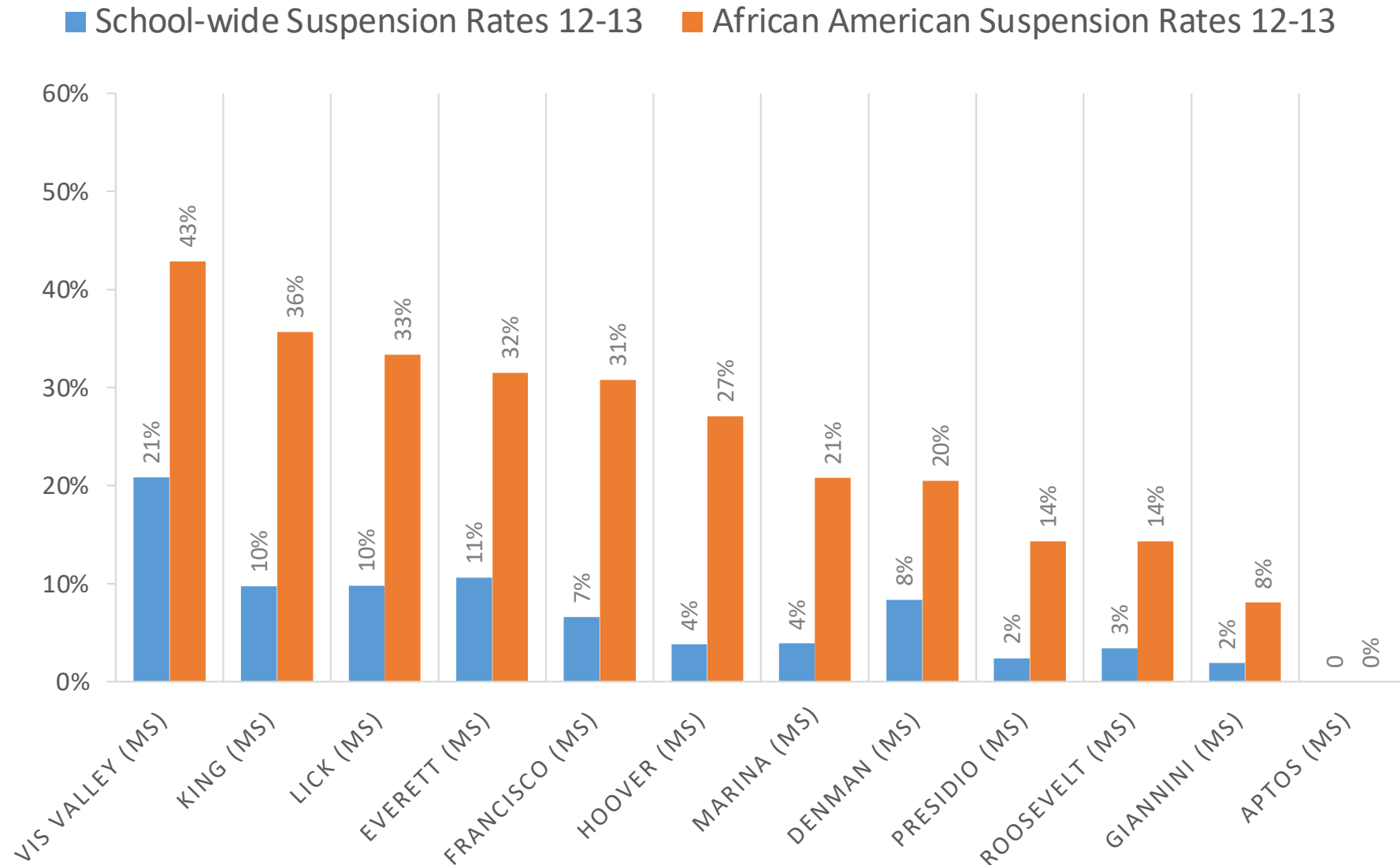

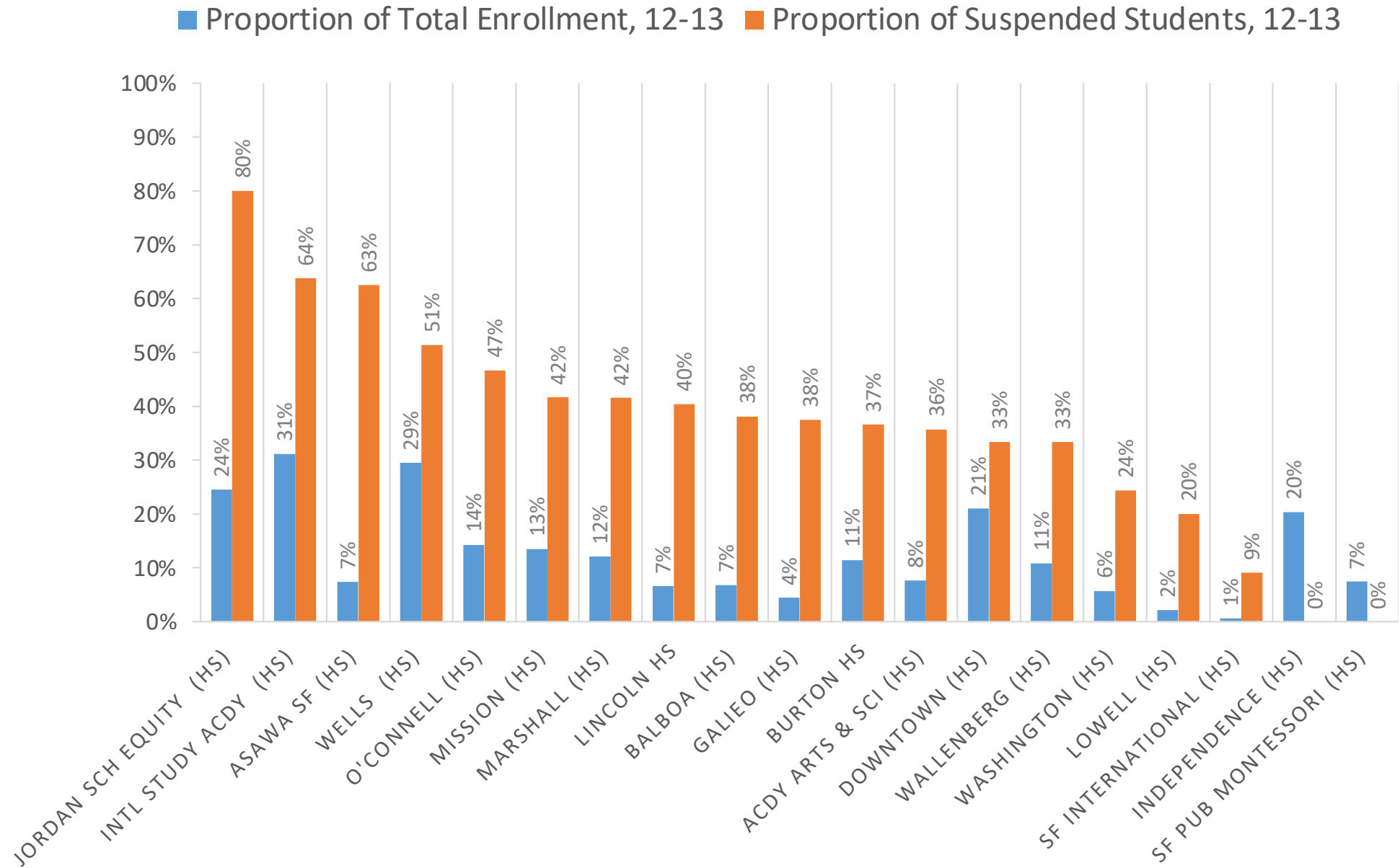
SFUSD High Schools: School-wide Suspension Rates vs. African American Suspension Rates



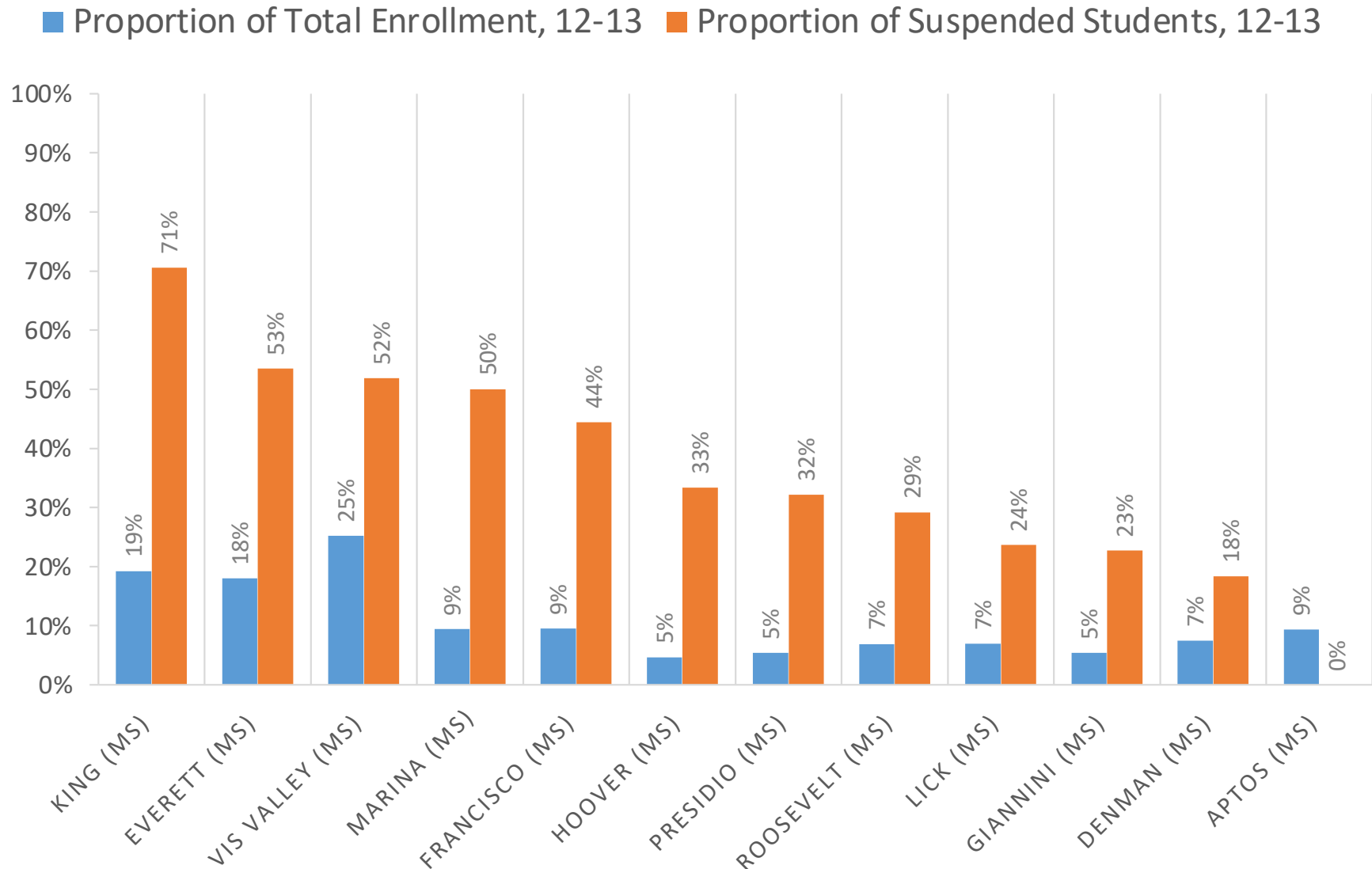
SFUSD Middle Schools: School-wide Suspension Rates vs. African American Suspension Rates



SFUSD African American High School Students: Proportion of Enrollment versus Proportion of Suspended Students

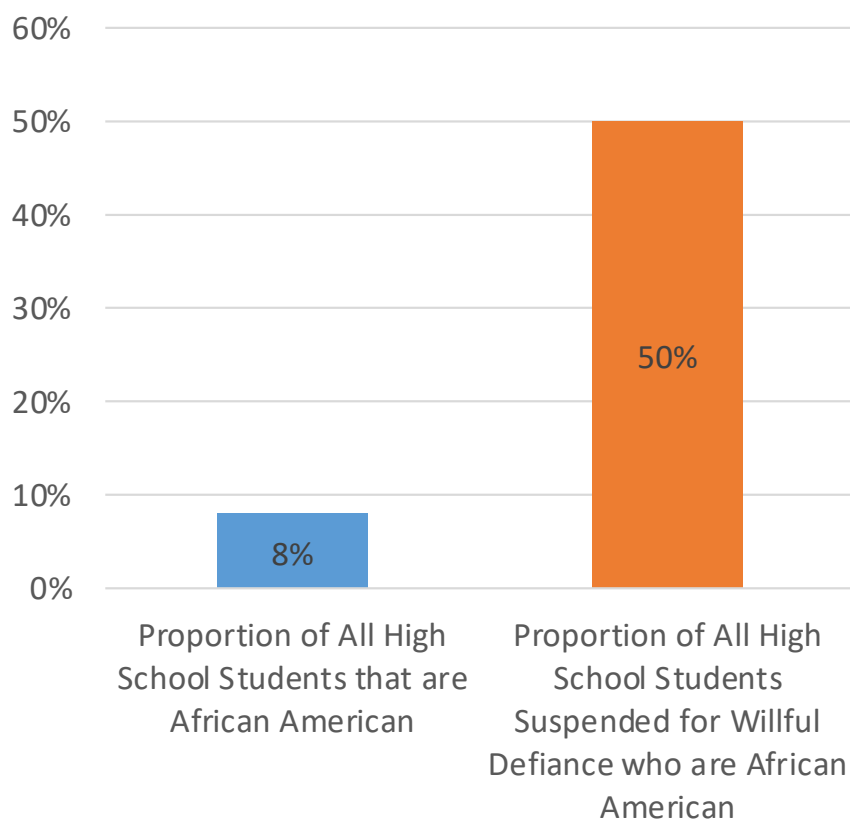


SFUSD African American Middle School Students: Proportion of Enrollment versus Proportion of Suspended Students

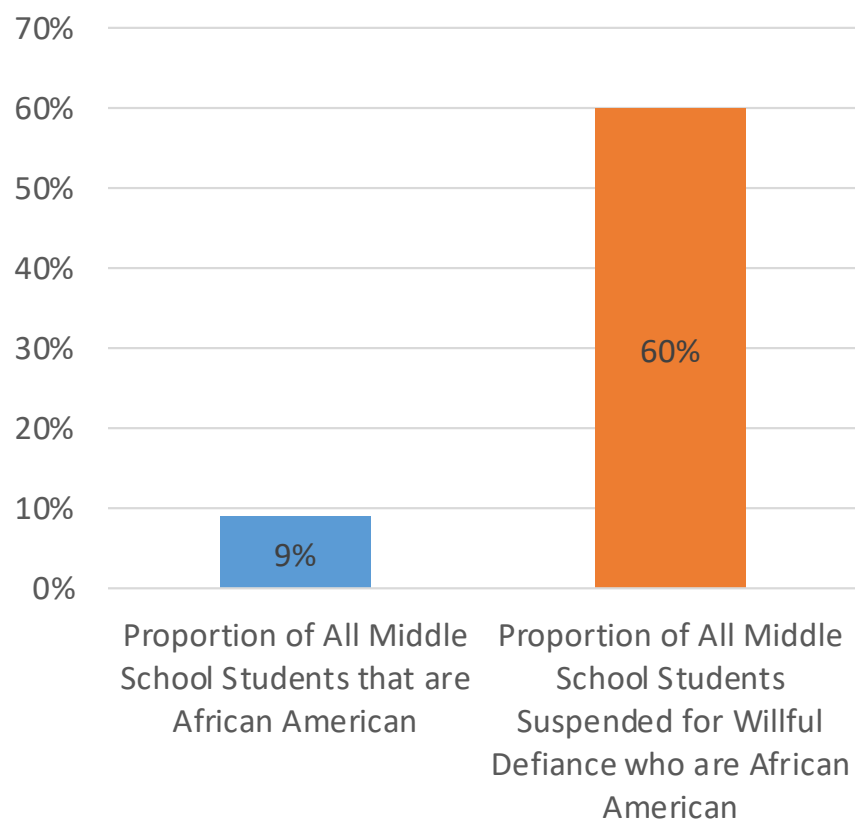


In SFUSD, African American students are over-represented among students suspended for willful defiance in secondary school

African American students represent only 8% of all high school students versus 50% of all high school students suspended for willful defiance

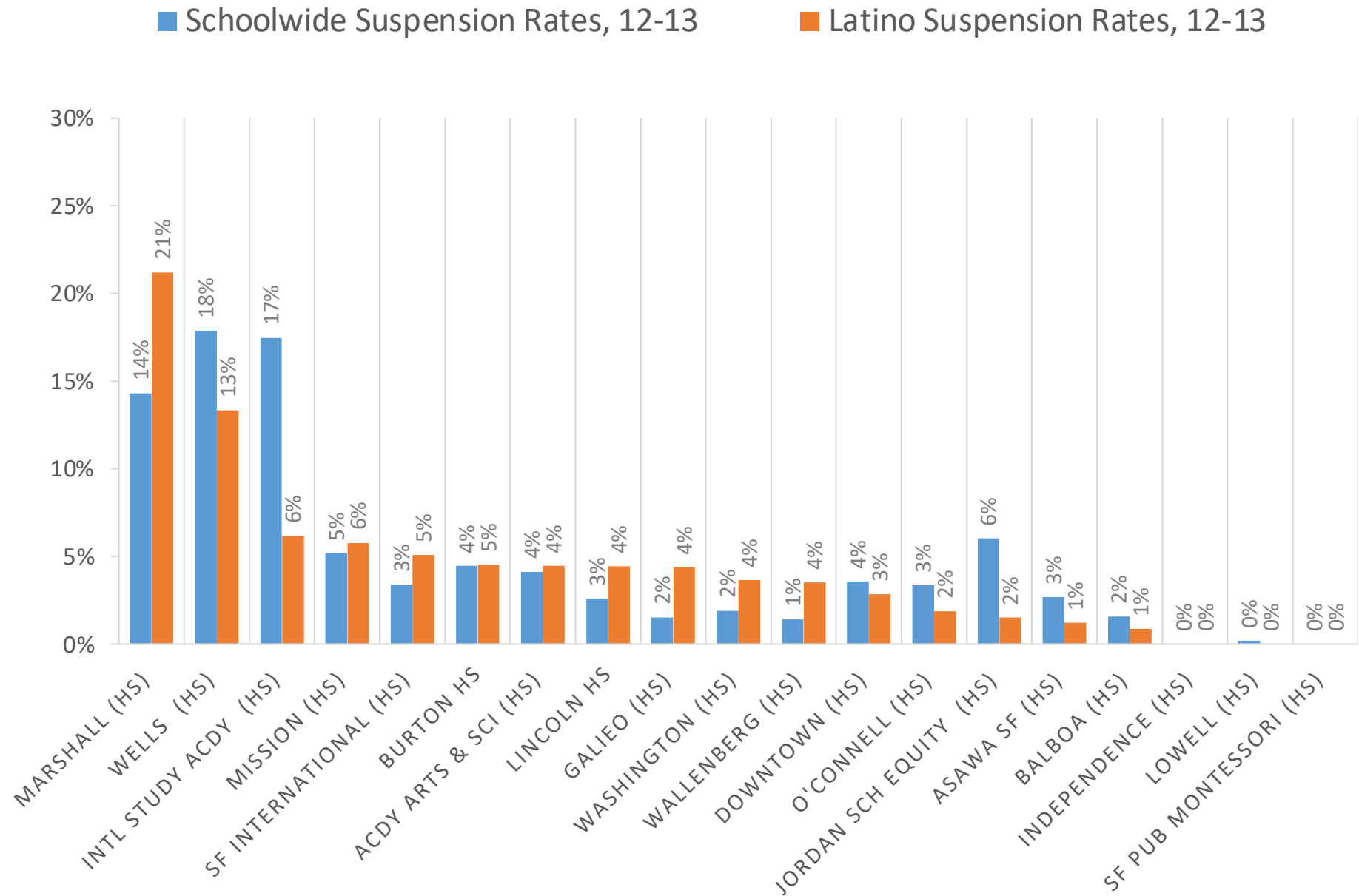


African American students represent only 9% of all middle school students versus 60% of all middle school students suspended for willful defiance
